Runs on the board

Over the past few months we have been involved in a number of great projects which I thought were worth a mention. Some time back we worked with architects Humphries Moss Cox to formulate timber flooring options for the new kindergarten buildings at Radford College. I'm pleased to say that we were successful in securing the contract to supply the flooring which ended up being Lemon Scented Spotted Gum. This job was approximately 550m² and was laid by Geoff Price from G& D Flooring. The floor was finished off with the Organoil Hardburnishing Oil. Because of timing issues on site we staggered the deliveries to suit the builder, Beasec Enterprises, and the flooring contractor. This wasn't a problem for us as we have our own truck so can plan most drops to within an hour and we stored the packs until required in our shed. Fourteen packs in all were delivered. I would like to thank all concerned for the opportunity to be involved.

Another job we have recently been a part of involved the supply of over twenty packs of Spotted Gum to rebuild the bridges burnt out at the Cotter during the Canberra fires. Acclaim Contractors engaged us to supply and deliver the timber cut in a range of sizes. This was specially ordered from the mill and again, delivered in several stages.

We have another large school floor coming up in country NSW in a few months. The timber has been ordered from the mill and is currently being produced to the clients specifications. We will tell you a little more about this one closer to the time.

Tas Oak

In the new stock part of our newsletter I was going to mention the recent arrival of another shipment of Tas Oak. When I looked at the list of stock on hand I thought it appropriate to give Tas Oak its own paragraph.

We have the following sizes in stock.

85 x 19 and 133 x 19 flooring

65 x 19 colonial architraves

Dressed boards in 90 x 90, 185 x 19, 285 x 19, 135 x 32, 285 x 32 and 290 x 45 F17.

Rough sawn boards in 300 x 50, 150 x 25, 250 x 38, 100 x 25, 150 x 38, 250 x 25, 100 x 38, 150 x 50, 75 x 50 and 250 x 25.

With these sizes and the quantities we keep, finding product to suit your needs should be easy enough. If you would like to check out our stock feel free to do so. Remember, we don't insist you take the top board in the stack. You are welcome to select through to find the boards you need so long as you leave the stack nice and tidy. This means you have control over the waste factor, colour and grain matching and minimizing any defects. Don't forget we can dress boards for you down to 1.5 mm if necessary.

New Stock.

We have 200 x 25 Brush Box on order, due in very soon. Recently we have received new stocks of 35mm Iron Bark and Spotted Gum, 150 x 25 and 100 x 38 Jarrah, 150 x 25 and 150 x 38 Blue Gum, 310 x 25 Kauri Pine, 25 x 38mm Tas Blackwood and 250 x 50 Karri from WA. I have mentioned before we have stock of Black Heart Sassafras and I recently had another look at it. The colour and figure is great. I am also chasing up some new Silky Oak and hope to see new stock shortly. Nearly forgot, we have 38mm Hickory up to 300mm wide.
